
Zoe Stathis

Lucas Kearney


Lucas is in second grade. He is eight years old and has two brothers named Ray and Calvin. He loves reading, playing piano, playing outside, and building.

The Chess Game



Steven is a fourth grade student. He likes to read and draw outside of school.




Daisy Bloodwell


Alexander is in first grade. He has a twin sister and an awesome older sister that he loves very dearly. He likes to do hip-hop dancing and play video games.


Ammar Sharaf
