		-No ripped or intentionally distressed bottoms
		-Stripes on pants are permitted as long as they are black, navy blue, or white.
		-Any logos should not exceed 1 inch in length/height
Tops	Solid colored shirts (navy blue, light blue, or white)	-Any logos should not exceed 1 inch in length/height
	Any official Penn Alexander shirts/t-shirts, including shirts from school sponsored events	-Sleeveless tops, including shirts with straps are not permitted and midriff must be fully covered.
Sweaters/ Sweatshirts	Navy Blue or Black solid colored hoodless sweater or sweatshirt	-Any logos should not exceed 1 inch in length/height

Shoes	Closed-toe shoes, sneakers, or boots – toes and heels must be covered	-No sandals or high heels of any kind
Accessories	Earrings are permitted as long as they are no la	rger than 1 inch in length

Dress Down Day	All tops and dresses must have a sleeve and fully cover the midriff – no strapless, halter, or tube tops No see-through shirts

	No ripped jeans or ripped pants of any kind above the knee	
	No inappropriate or derogatory language, images, or messages on any item of clothing
