

Domestic Worker Bill of Rights Law

Starting May 1, 2020, the Domestic Worker Bill of Rights requires all employers of in-home service workers to provide certain protections.

Employers include homeowners, and businesses.

In-home service workers include Nannies, House Cleaners, and Caregivers.

Domestic workers must receive the following:

- ✓ A written contract with minimum terms of agreement.
- Two weeks severance pay or two weeks notice.
- ✓ Paid meal and rest breaks.
- ✓ Paid time off.
- Legal protections against discrimination, surveillance and human trafficking.
- ✓ Protections against retaliation, including threats to immigration status and other protections.

These protections are regardless of immigrations status, race or ethnicity.
