

Note to parents of rising Kindergartners and 1st graders: Your child(ren)'s school supplies for these grades will be purchased by the teachers. You can pay the \$50/75-per-child fee through the HSA website.

We're excited to make good use of valuable school supplies and prevent usable items from going to a landfill. 


Term: The new board will take office on July 1, 2023, and serve a two-year term (for the 2023–2024 and 2024-2025 school years) - until June 30, 2025.


