- Budget
 - Budget has been released. Overall, PAS has been able to maintain status quo and improve in some areas. Funding was better than projected due to a lack of realization on project attrition.
 - Next 3 weeks will be spent on Budget planning. Currently PAS requires about \$8.5M to Operate. Approx. 200K is provided through HSA
 - Meeting with teachers on Budget has taken place to integrate feedback and ensure that materials are ordered in a timely fashion to ensure availability when school starts in the fall.
- Update:

 - For next year, would like to expand affinity events to include additional groups like LGBTQ, Neurodiveristy and others.
 - Opportunity to do some diligence to identify other affinity subgroups that would benefit from organized events.
