Principal Report

- We have our 2nd STAR testing data set of the year
 - Overall growth is above the average projection
 - This growth seen across all racial groups, multilanguage learners, students with IEPs
- Increase in attendance in December: 90% of students made the mark
- Conferences coming up, including one late-night conference
- Pancake breakfast is coming up! Please come!
- 5K planning has started
- Field project is moving along
- Winter afterschool club cycle is opening up
- Radical Readers partnership w/Penn GSE to start its 2nd year
 - 6-week intervention program for K-8 kids who need additional reading support

Open Forum: Student Mental Health

- Neurodiversity group update
 - Vidya to participate in Neurodiversity & Disability Support Circle, part of the Family Impact Initiative
 - Group meets 1x/month
 - Vidya to pursue Philadelphia Autism Project grant application
 - We can definitely do a book list w/Ms Ross
 - We can also do a spirit/awareness week w/Autism Speaks
- Student mental health
 - Biggest gap is getting services for kids where external barriers are in place (ie transportation to and from therapy)
 - PAS can triage & help people find resources & services; we are a liaison to kids getting the services that they need
 - We also provide support to teachers who work with these kids & help them to be responsive to what kids need
 - We want ALL our kids to understand their feelings, be able to identify & talk about their feelings
 - We do this in SEL, our 1st-tier response to kids' mental health needs

- SEL is an important weekly class for our kids. Keeping this position funded is a priority
- Our social work team is part-time, not full-time. Penn School of Social Policy & Practice (SP2) provides our paid staff member (Beth Clauss) who then assigns SP2 students
 - Would be great to have full-time social work, but we don't have the funding. Most PhilaSD schools don't have full time social work
 - Beth's salary is outside of PSD budget; it is paid by SP2
 - Can we get information about what covering the gap would look like?
- Top of principal Overton's wish list
 - Full-time social work staff member
 - Maintaining funding for intervention
 - Maintaining funding for SEL
 - Social work staff to align families with parent coaching resources
